10. Fee Rules

- Fee should be deposited by cash on or before the due date given in Instalment Plan. In case of Cheque - Account payee cheque must be given in name of "Bhandari Public School" payable at Khandwa. Only local cheques will be accepted.
- No deduction is made in the fee for the absence of children.
- It is advised to the parents that they should obtain 'No Dues Certificate' from the Accounts Office, before the Final Examination in prescribed format; without which, the Admit Card for Examination may not be given to appear in the examination.
- Bus & Mess facility is available as optional. Once opted, it is to be used for the whole session and not for any part thereof. Only those who wish to utilize it for the whole session should take it otherwise no refund will be made.
- One month's notice is to be given before withdrawing a student.
- Fee can be deposited in any one of the two (Options) modes-(a) Lumpsum full fee 1 time (b) in five equal instalments Due dates are - (With Out Late Fee) (With a Late Fee of Rs. 10/- Per Day)

I instalment	-	10th April	20th April
II instalment	-	10th July	20th July
III instalment	-	10th September	20th September
IV instalment	-	10th November	20th November
V instalment	-	10th January	20th January
- Through lumpsum (single payment) it can be deposited once only on or before 10th April.
- If fee is not paid as per the last date given above, it should be paid with a fine @ Rs.10/- per day, from the last date of the installment; failing to do so, the name of the child may be struck off from the roll and re-admission fee of Rs. 1000/- will be charged, if re-admission is granted by the Principal.
- In case fee is not paid till 10th April, if parent is paying fee during or after summer vacation in July or later month, it is mandatory to pay fee

along with fine @ 10/- per day from due date (10th April) till payment is made

(including May & June month's fine).

10. Five days grace period is given if payment is made through cheque i.e. cheques will be accepted till 15th of the respective Instalment due date. In case the cheque is dishonoured, fee has to be deposited in cash, with a fine of Rs. 200/- and Bank charge as charged by the Bank.
12. No deduction is made in transport, mess & school fee for the absence of children.
13. New Academic session begins from March / April every year. If fee is not paid by due date then fine @ Rs. 10/- per day will be levied from the due date till fee is paid.
14. Once mess option is taken, it will not be changed during the current session. Mess menu will be available month wise on school's website - www.bhandarischool.com
15. Transport facility is given for one academic session. Once it is started, it won't be stopped during the session.

11. Bus Rules

1. Bus facility is provided by school and it is optional.
2. It is the responsibility of the parents to see the children are made to board the bus and escorted home on return journey, in the after noon from their respective bus stop.
3. If there is no one to pickup the child (Nursery to III in particular) at the bus stop the child will be brought back to the school, then either of the parents, will have to come and escort the child home. This will be strictly followed.
4. No oral request of parents will be considered, to drop the child other than decided stop. In a very rare case parent's request may be considered if given in writing about the change of stop, No student will be allowed to board any other bus except his/her regular one.
6. Students Should stand 5 minutes before at their respective stops.
7. Any change in bus timing, will be notified in advance in writing.
8. Proper discipline should be maintained in the bus.

9. Any sort of misconduct will be taken strictly.
10. Parents are requested that in case of any complaint talk to the authority and not to fight with drivers or conductors.
11. In case of change of Route / address please apply in the format given in the Almanac. and submit to the office of Principal.

12. Attendance Rules

1. Students have to be regular and punctual to school.
2. Please ensure that your ward comes to school regularly as 75 % attendance is compulsory for every student.(As per CBSE By Laws).
3. Your ward must not remain absent from the school without application for more than three days. If so then the school may take strict action.
4. Before the departure time, please avoid calling your ward, except in an emergency.
5. Avoid sending your ward in case of any contagious disease, till h/she recovers completely.
6. If a student turns up for any particular day(s) late, he/she must have the Late Coming Record duly filled and signed by the parents before he/she reports to school.
7. Whenever the student is absent or on leave, the relevant pages (School Parent contact) in the handbook should have an entry for the same signed by the parent at the time of reporting after leave.

13. School Rules

1. Each child should carry I.D. and hand book every day.
2. Every student in the school is expected to converse only in English.
3. Discipline, decency and decorum should be maintained by each student, while talking to the Principal, Head Mistress, teachers, guests, classmates and other staff including Transport, Kitchen and Peons too.
4. No student will be allowed to leave the school premises without permission of the Principal/Director.
5. Reason of absence must be entered in the leave record of hand book on specific page.
6. Students are supposed to submit the allotted work on time.
7. Attendance shall only be granted to the student if he/she attends the first 4 periods.

8. Wearing jewelry is strictly forbidden. Students are advised not to come with valuable articles in the school.
9. Before you enter in the school please check your **dress, hair, shoes etc.**
Your turn up should be good and up to the mark.
10. Care must be taken to keep the campus clean. Plucking of leaves & flowers is strictly prohibited.
11. Any damage to school property is chargeable.
12. Carrying Mobile / other Gadgets are strictly prohibited in school campus. If it is found with the child, minimum Rs. 1000 fine will be charged and it will be handed over to the parents.

14. Library Rules

1. Perfect silence and order must be maintained in the library.
2. Only one book at a time will be issued on allotted days.
3. Books borrowed from the library must be returned in the good condition and within the stipulated time to avoid overdue charges.
4. If any book borrowed is lost, **THE STUDENT WILL HAVE TO BORNE THE PRICE.**
5. All library books must be returned by the end of the academic year for stock verification.

15. Notes to Parents / Guardians

1. Parents must go through the monthly circulars/SMS as they contain the record of all the activities.
2. Parents must attend PTMs. PTM schedule is given.
3. For any change in the personal details, school should be well informed through proper supporting documents.
4. In case of personal meetings with the authorities, please seek the prior permission.
5. Uniform defaulters should carry a note written and signed by parent

16. Examination Rules & Policy:

1. No leave will be entertained during examination in any circumstances.
2. Any kind of Exams will neither be pre-poned nor postponed for any reason.
3. **If ABSENCE DUE TO – PARTICIPATION IN SCHOOL SPORTS CONDUCTED BY THE DISTRICT / STATE** in such special cases, the decision may be taken by the principal.
4. We follow **No Re Examination policy**, hence the child whoever will miss any particular exam won't be awarded any type of marks in that particular exam. The child will be marked absent.
5. In case of any medical issue, the student needs to present a **Medical Certificate from a certified MBBS Doctor**. Marking in such conditions will entirely be as per the jurisdiction of the examination department and school authorities.
6. The school maintains the Sovereignty over rules and policies regarding examinations and no interventions of any stakeholders will be entertained in the official matters of the organization.
7. Decision of the **Principal will be final & binding.**

17. Safety & Security

CCTV systems are installed both internally and externally in our school for the purpose of enhancing security of the building, buses and its associated equipment as well as creating a mindfulness among the occupants, at any one time, that a surveillance security system is in operation within and/or in the external environs of the premises during both the daylight and night hours each day.

The primary aim of CCTV monitoring is to deter crime and vandalism and to assist in the protection and safety of the staff, students and visitors, school property and its associated equipment and materials.

Video monitoring and recording is for security purposes and is limited to school management use only.
